

## **Raphoe Flood Relief Scheme**

The town of Raphoe, Co. Donegal has suffered flooding in recent years from a combination of fluvial and pluvial flooding, notably in September 2006, June 2007 and most recently again in August 2017.

In March 2013, OPW commissioned RPS to undertake the Raphoe Flood Assessment and Management (FRAM) Study. The aim of this study was to further assess and develop measures to manage existing flood risk in Raphoe town that would comprise of a feasibility and preparation of a Flood Risk Management Plan.

Tender documents for the main and environmental consultants to advance a flood relief scheme for Raphoe were published on the eTenders website in July 2017. The assessment panel, upon review of the tender submissions received, selected the most economically advantageous tenderers. The successful tenderers shall be appointed pending the completion of the standstill period.
