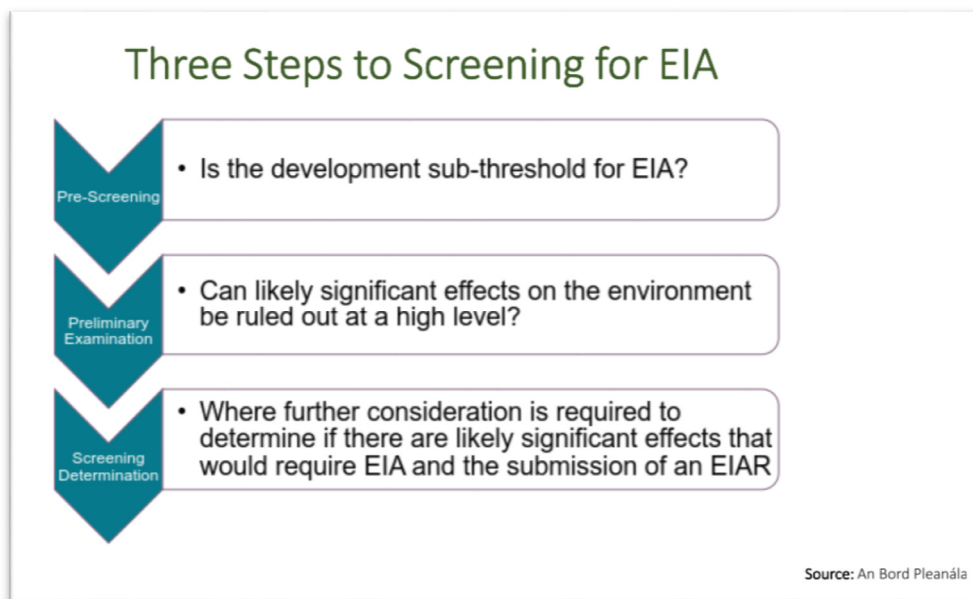


## SCREENING FOR EIA



### PRE-SCREENING

#### 1. *Is the development sub-threshold for EIA?*

The subject proposal consists of the following works at An Garda Síochána, Ballinhassig Garda Station, Halfway, Ballinhassig, Co. Cork T12 K125:

The development will consist of the addition of a universal access ramp and steps to the side elevation of the existing prefab station, the widening of the front entrance doorway to the side elevation and the addition of light standards and thermoplastic paint markings denoting a universal access car parking space and a pedestrian route from the site entrance up to the universal access ramp.

#### 2. *Assessment*

The above works are not within a Class under Part 1 or Part 2 of Schedule 5 of the *Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended)*.

#### 3. *Conclusion*

It can be concluded at Pre-Screening stage that an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is not required and no further action in the form of a Preliminary Examination or an EIA Screening is required. Therefore, the public notification requirements – re: the conclusions of the preliminary examination or screening determination – under Articles 87, 88 and 89 of Part 9 of the *Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended by S.I. 296 of 2018)* do not apply.
